WCA will once again be offering summer camps this year! Class sizes will be limited, so please register early. Registrations will be taken first-come, first-served until slots are filled. You may register for as few or as many weeks as you would like. Full-time Camp hours are 7:00 am -5:30 pm, Monday-Friday with core camp hours from 9:00 am -1:00 pm. Core Camp hours are when all "thematic" activities will take place. June 19 and July 4 will be observed as holidays. The daily schedule will consist of academic instruction, hands-on craft activities related to the theme, outside play time, and quiet time. We hope to be able to offer some field trips for older students as well. Summer Camps will run from June 5-July 28 (no camps the week of Memorial Day or the week before school starts).

COST OF CAMP

Core Camp (9:00-1:00) is \$75 per week per child. Full Time Camp (any hours outside of core hours) is \$115 per week per child. Full Time Camp includes core camp hours.

To register, please fill out a registration form and return to the WCA office with a non-refundable deposit of \$20 per week per child to hold your spot. The balance will be billed June 5 for June camps and July 3 for July camps. Tuition is due by the 10th of each month.

Week 1, June 5-9 Out of this World

Come join us as we explore Space. We will learn about living in space, gravity, and maybe even launch a rocket or two.

Week 2, June 12-16 Animal Planet

Kids will spend time immersed in everything animal. We will focus on the diversity of animals and their environments in which they live. We will have educational activities including games, crafts, guest speakers, and more!

Week 3, June 20-23 (June 19 is a HOLIDAY) Bugs/Insects

Creepy Crawly and so much fun! Join us as we learn about different bugs and insects and why they are important to our world.

Week 4, June 26-June 30 Science

This week we will explore the world of science and how science can be fun! Be prepared to get messy!

Week 5, July 3-July 7(July 4 is HOLIDAY) Arts & Crafts

This week will focus on making things with our hands. We will learn about colors, textures, and art mediums while we make memories.

Week 6, July 10-July 14 Stories from the Bible

Come take a journey with us as we explore parables from God's word and learn how we can relate stories from God's word to our world today.

Week 7, July 17-21 Reading

We will explore books written by the award-winning author Dr. Suess. We will look at how he used rhyming words to create stories that capture your imagination.

Week 8, July 24-28 Wild World of Water

Our final week of camp will focus on the substance that covers over 70% of Earth's surface-water! We will learn about the water cycle, the importance of water in everyday life, and of course, water play. Water balloons may be a staple this week[©]

Each student at camp is expected to exhibit cordial and respectful behavior. Inappropriate or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated. Referrals made to the administrator for behavior may result in disciplinary action. A progressive discipline plan will be followed. Consequences may range from a conversation regarding behavior to expulsion from current and all subsequent summer camps. Circumstances of the situation, and the severity of those circumstances, may determine the level of discipline and preclude the progressive path. Severe infractions or when the safety of a student/students is involved will result in immediate referral to the administrator. Students suspended or expelled due to behavior infractions will not receive a refund of any deposits paid.

Balance of \$55 for core camp/\$95 for full time per week is due by the 10th of each month. Fees may be paid in advance by check, cash, PayPal (wiregrassca@entercomp.com), Venmo (Sandra-Turner-104) or credit card (3% fee for processing credit cards).

I understand that the \$20 deposit is non-refundable unless Wiregrass Christian Academy is unable to fulfill its obligation to have camp. In the event that WCA must cancel a camp session(s), the deposit paid will be credited to the child's account or refunded if the child will not be returning to WCA in the future. I agree to keep my child at home if they are feeling unwell. I will not return my child to WCA until they have been fever free WITHOUT THE AID OF MEDICATION for 24 hours following an illness.

I understand I must give notice at least 48 hours in advance if my child will not be attending a camp for which they are registered. Failure to give notice will result in you being charged for the entire camp fee as teachers will already be in place to work.

Failure to adhere to these policies will result in your child being disenrolled from all summer camps and forfeiture of any deposits paid.
