

WCA will once again be offering summer camps this year! Class sizes will be limited, so please register early. Registrations will be taken first-come, first-served until slots are filled. You may register for as few or as many weeks as you would like. Full-time Camp hours are 7:00 am -5:30 pm, Monday-Friday with core camp hours from 9:00 am -1:00 pm. Core Camp hours are when all "thematic" activities will take place. June 19 and July 4 will be observed as holidays. The daily schedule will consist of academic instruction, hands-on craft activities related to the theme, outside play time, and quiet time. We hope to be able to offer some field trips for older students as well. Summer Camps will run from June 2-July 25 (no camps the week of Memorial Day or the week before school starts).

COST OF CAMP

Core Camp (9:00-1:00) is \$85 per week per child. Full Time Camp (any hours outside of core hours) is \$125 per week per child. Full Time Camp includes core camp hours.

To register, please fill out a registration form and return to the WCA office with a non-refundable deposit of \$20 per week per child to hold your spot. The balance will be billed June 2 for June camps and July 1 for July camps. Tuition is due by the 10th of each month.

Week 1, June 2-6: Farmyard Fun

Campers will enjoy hands-on activities like planting a garden, starting their own plants, learning about farm animals, and the importance of caring for the land God has given us. Psalm 145:15

Week 2, June 9-13: God's Masterpiece

Campers will dive into the world of art, discovering famous styles from iconic artists like Michelangelo, Henri Matisse, Picasso, Claude Monet, and the Quilters of Gee's Bend. Students will reflect on how God, the ultimate creator, makes each of us His masterpiece. Ephesians 2:10

Week 3, June 16-20 (June 19 is a HOLIDAY): Making a Joyful Noise

Campers will learn about famous composers, make and play fun instruments, and sing praises to the Lord. Children will explore the ways that music can be used to uplift one another and offer praise to God. Psalm 95:1

Week 4, June 23-27: STEAM

Through engaging science, technology, engineering and math activities, campers will learn to build and make with a variety of materials according to their age. Children will learn about the importance of teamwork, perseverance, and faith as they work together to reflect God's vision of community and creation. Nehemiah 2:17

Week 5, June 30-July 3 (July 4 is HOLIDAY): Calling all Superheroes!

Campers will dive into Bible stories and powerful lessons of courage, justice, and mercy, learning what it means to be a hero in God's Kingdom. Joshua 1:9

Week 6, July 7-11: Ocean Explorers

Young adventurers will embark on an unforgettable voyage with the Lord as their Captain. We'll sail through biblical tales of Noah's Ark, Jonah and the Great Fish, and Jesus' miracles on the water, discovering God's never-ending presence in every wave. Psalm 146:6

Week 7, July 14-18: Space Quest

Embark on a journey that explores the wonders of God's creation beyond the stars. Just as God called forth the heavens and the earth, students will dive deep into the mysteries of the cosmos, discovering the beauty and vastness of His creation. Isaiah 40:26

Week 8, July 21-25: Let the Games Begin!

Just as the ancient Olympic Games honored physical skills, our camp challenges will honor the spiritual endurance that comes from trusting in God's strength and guidance. Inspired by the biblical examples of determination and faith, we'll look to the stories of the Bible's greatest champions. Philippians 4:13

Each student at camp is expected to exhibit cordial and respectful behavior. Inappropriate or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated. Referrals made to the administrator for behavior may result in disciplinary action. A progressive discipline plan will be followed. Consequences may range from a conversation regarding behavior to expulsion from current and all subsequent summer camps. Circumstances of the situation, and the severity of those circumstances, may determine the level of discipline and preclude the progressive path. Severe infractions or when the safety of a student/students is involved will result in immediate referral to the administrator. Students suspended or expelled due to behavior infractions will not receive a refund of any deposits paid.
